On June 28, 2024, the Public Service Commission (Commission) issued Orders granting the request of Enbridge Gas Utah (“EGU”) to implement the rates in the above referenced dockets 24-057-08, 24-057-09 and 22-057-03. In Docket No. 24-057-09, the Commission denied the Company’s request to change language in section 2.06 of the Tariff. EGU respectfully submits the attached Tariff sheets in compliance with these Orders.

The attached Tariff sheets include rates associated with Docket Nos. 24-057-08, 24-057-09 and 22-057-03. Section 2.06, which had the denied tariff language, has been removed from these Tariff sheets. The Tariff Sheets in dockets 24-057-08, 24-057-09 and 22-057-03 are effective July 1, 2024 and the sections impacted by these Tariff sheets are Sections 2.02, 2.03, 2.04, 4.02, 5.02, 5.03, 5.04, 5.05 and 5.06. Pursuant to Utah Admin. Code §R746-405-2(D)(3)(g), the Company represents that the Tariff sheets do not constitute a violation of state law or Commission rule.
