Re: *Enbridge Gas Utah's Energy Efficiency Reports, 2025, Docket No. 25-057-05, Enbridge Gas Utah's Application for Approval of the 2025 Year Budget for Energy Efficiency Programs and Market Transformation Initiative, Docket No. 24-057-22*

Dear Mr. Orton:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Enbridge Gas Utah's (EGU) (formerly, Dominion Energy Utah) November 14, 2025 filing of its Energy Efficiency ("EE") Report for the quarter ending September 30, 2025 ("Report").¹ The EE Report provides 2025 third quarter totals for EGU's energy efficiency programs, including program participation, costs, and natural gas savings. Simultaneously, EGU filed a Report on Energy Efficiency Expenditures and Dekatherm Savings to Date ("DSM Expenditures Report").² The DSM Expenditures Report states that the Weatherization program reached 86.7 percent of its allocated budget prior to August 31 and reached 95.8 percent prior to September 30.

The Division of Public Utilities (DPU) submitted comments on December 4, 2025. DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge EGU's DSM Expenditures Report. DPU represents, "[t]he Company forecasts that the Weatherization Program will exceed its

budget at one hundred twenty-eight percent (128%) of the \$8.29 million 2025 budget by the end of the year. However, the Company forecasts that the ThermWise[®] programs in total will not exceed the 2025 Commission-approved budget of \$30.8 million.”³ Additionally, DPU states, “[it] will continue to monitor the DSM program activity and expenditures by reviewing the detailed quarterly reports.”⁴

Based on the PSC’s review and DPU’s comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges the Weatherization Program’s expenses are forecasted to exceed the PSC-approved 2025 budget, but ThermWise® programs’ spending in total is forecasted to be within budget. Additionally, the PSC acknowledges the EE Report and DSM Expenditures Report.
