The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the June 19, 2025 filing by Enbridge Gas Utah (EGU)¹ of its updates to the Infrastructure Rate Adjustment Mechanism ("Filing"). The Filing was made pursuant to paragraph 22.b of the Partial Settlement Stipulation ("Stipulation") approved by the PSC on February 21, 2014 in Docket No. 13-057-05. The Stipulation requires EGU to file with the PSC updates to certain pipeline lists and schedules, including new construction and replacement work, in the docket associated with that year's annual budget filing. Pursuant to the PSC's February 25, 2020 Report and Order in Docket No. 19-057-02, the updates are due by June 30 of each year.

The PSC also reviewed the July 9, 2025 Action Request Response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). The DPU confirmed that the information provided in the Filing adheres to paragraph 22.b of the Stipulation, stating it "appears that the program is proceeding as designed and agreed to, albeit at a much, much slower pace."² DPU recommended the PSC acknowledge the Filing as compliant with the PSC orders referenced above.
