DOMINION ENERGY UTAH'S VERIFIED APPLICATION

Pursuant to Utah Admin Code R746-405-2, Dominion Energy Utah (Dominion Energy Utah or Company) respectfully requests the Utah Public Service Commission's (Commission) approval of the attached and updated Section 8.07 of the Company's Utah Natural Gas Tariff No. 600 (Tariff), effective April 1, 2023. The proposed changes update the Company's carrying charge to 5.35%. If approved, the updated interest rate will apply to Dominion Energy Utah accounts 182.3, 182.4, 182.45, 191.1, 191.4, 191.5, 191.8, 191.9 and 235.1.

On February 23, 2017, the Commission issued an order in Docket No. 17-057-T01 approving a change in the carrying charges applied to Dominion Energy Utah accounts 182.3, 182.4, 191.1, 191.8, 191.9 and 235.1, and detailing the method for calculating the carrying charges. Section 8.07 of the Tariff also details how to calculate the carrying charge. It says:

On or before March 1 of each year, the Company shall calculate an annual carrying charge and file a letter with the Commission reflecting this rate, to be effective on April 1 of each year. This charge shall be based on the average annual Aaa and Baa Corporate interest rates for the preceding calendar year.

Accordingly, the Company has calculated an updated interest rate of 5.35%, based upon

Aaa and Baa Corporate interest rates for 2023 as published in the Mergent Bond Record. The

rates provided by Mergent and the calculation are shown in the following table:

The updated interest rate is shown in the legislative and proposed Section 8.07 of the Tariff, attached as DEU Exhibits 1.01 and 1.02, respectively. This proposed Tariff change does not constitute a violation of a state law or Commission rule, and approval of this application is just, reasonable and in the public interest.

Based upon the foregoing, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission approve the proposed Tariff change with an effective date of April 1, 2024.


