Application of Enbridge Gas Utah to Modify its Tariff to reflect its Name change.

Recommendation (Approval with Condition)

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission of Utah (Commission) approve with conditions the Corrected EGU Exhibit 2.0 Tariff filed by Enbridge Gas Utah (EGU or Company) on June 13, 2024, and with an effective date of July 1, 2024.

Issue

On June 3, 2024, EGU submitted its application to the Commission and attached its revised Tariff reflecting the name change from Dominion Energy to Enbridge Gas Utah. On June 3, 2024, the Commission issued an Action Request for the Division to review for compliance and make recommendations by June 18, 2024. On June 5, 2024, the Commission issued its Notice of Filing and Comment Period indicating interested persons may submit comments by June 18, 2024, with reply comments due June 25, 2024. On June 12, 2024, EGU filed corrected tariff sheets to reflect only the name-change, correct Advice Numbers, and correct Section Revision references. On June 19, 2024, the Commission issued a Second Action

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Request for the Division to review and recommend how to reconcile inconsistencies between the corrected EGU Exhibits 1.0 and 2.0 by June 24, 2024. This memo is in response to the Commission's Second Action Request.

Discussion

On June 19, 2024, the Commission issued a follow-up action request regarding the corrected tariff sheets filed by EGU on June 14, 2024. Corrected Exhibit 1.0 (the legislative copy) includes the Dominion Energy logo which has not been stricken through in redline on pages 8-1 to 8-22, 9-16 to 9-18, 10-1, and 11-1 to 11-10. The Division spoke with the Company, and there appears to be a formatting issue with Microsoft Word that only affects the header in those sections. EGU stated there are no other inconsistencies between Corrected Exhibit 1.0 and Corrected Exhibit 2.0. This issue does not impact rates and is only an administrative correction. The proposed tariff sheets are correct and are ultimately what is posted with the public. EGU will submit an updated legislative tariff sheet by the end of the day on July 26, 2024, to match the proposed tariff sheet.

Conclusion

The Division finds that there is no fundamental difference between the Legislative and Proposed sheets. The Proposed version is correct. The Legislative version has the Dominion Energy logo on pages 8-1 to 8-22, 9-16 to 9-18, 10-1, and 11-1 to 11-10. EGU will make necessary corrections to the Legislative tariff sheets. Therefore, the Division recommends the Commission approve the tariff name change with the condition of receiving the Corrected Exhibit 2.0 tariff sheet with an effective date of July 1, 2024.
