Re: *Application of Enbridge Gas Utah to Modify its Tariff to Reflect its Name Change*; Docket No. 24-057-T03

Dear Ms. Clark,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Questar Gas Company dba Enbridge Gas Utah's (EGU), June 3, 2024 filing proposing to modify its Utah Natural Gas Tariff No. 700 to reflect its name change, effective July 1, 2024. The PSC has also reviewed EGU's corrected exhibits 1.0 (legislative version) and 2.0 (proposed clean version) (the "Corrected Exhibit 1.0" and "Corrected Exhibit 2.0," respectively), filed June 13, 2024.¹ Corrected Exhibit 1.0 and Corrected Exhibit 2.0 are referred to, together, as the "Revised Tariffs." DPU filed comments on June 18, 2024 and June 24, 2024. No other parties filed comments.

The DPU concludes that EGU's proposed Revised Tariffs comply with the PSC's Order Approving Settlement Stipulation issued May 16, 2024 in Docket No. 23-057-16, "Joint Application of Questar Gas Company dba Dominion Energy Utah and Enbridge Quail Holdings, LLC for Approval of the Proposed Sale of Fall West Holdco, LLC to Enbridge Quail Holdings, LLC." Additionally, DPU states it supports an exception to the 30-day requirement² since there is no impact on customer rates and recommends approval of the proposed Revised Tariffs.

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In response to the PSC's request relating to continued inconsistencies in the Revised Tariffs, DPU also filed comments on June 24, 2024. It explains that a formatting issue with Microsoft Word is the reason the DEU logo is still included in Corrected Exhibit 1.0, but not included in Corrected Exhibit 2.0. DPU confirms EGU's representation that there are no other inconsistencies between Corrected Exhibits 1.0 and 2.0. DPU further explains that the formatting issue does not impact rates and is only an administrative correction. DPU represents that EGU will submit an updated legislative tariff sheet by June 26, 2024.³ Based on the representation that a revised Corrected Exhibit 1.0 will be filed by June 26, 2024, DPU recommends the PSC approve the filing, conditioned on the filing of a second corrected Exhibit 1.0 that excludes the DEU logo.

Based on the PSC's review of EGU's filings and DPU's comments and follow up comments, the PSC waives the 30-day requirement and approves the Revised Tariffs, effective July 1, 2024, conditioned on the filing of a revised Corrected Exhibit 1.0.
