Questar Gas Company dba Enbridge Gas Utah ("Enbridge", "EGU" or the "Company") respectfully moves the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") to modify the Scheduling Order, Notice of Technical Conferences, Notice of Public Witness Hearings, and Notice of Hearings issued on May 13, 2025 in this matter ("Scheduling Order").

In support of this motion, Enbridge states as follows:

1. On May 1, 2025, Enbridge filed the Application in this matter.
2. On May 13, 2025, the Commission issued the Scheduling Order bifurcating the issues into Phase I and Phase II and setting forth dates for testimony and hearings for Phase I and Phase II, among other things.
3. Since that time, the Company has engaged in settlement discussions with all parties to this matter: the Utah Division of Public Utilities (“Division”), the Utah Office of Consumer Services (“Office”), the Federal Executive Agencies (“FEA”), the Utah Association of Energy Users (“UAE”), the American Natural Gas Council (“ANGC”), and Nucor Steel-Utah, a Division of Nucor Corporation (“Nucor”).
4. According to the Scheduling Order, Phase I Written Rebuttal Testimony is due to be filed on September 23, 2025. In furtherance of pursuing the ongoing settlement discussions, Enbridge requests that the deadline for Phase I Written Rebuttal Testimony be extended to September 26, 2025.
5. Enbridge has communicated with the other parties to this matter—Division, Office, FEA, UAE, ANGC, and Nucor—and is authorized to represent that the other parties have no objection to this motion.
6. As such, good cause exists to grant the Company’s motion as the remainder of the schedule is not impacted and no party is harmed.

WHEREFORE, based upon the foregoing, Enbridge Gas Utah respectfully requests that the Commission extend the deadline for Phase I Written Rebuttal Testimony to September 26, 2025 and issue a revised scheduling order accordingly.
