Application of Enbridge Gas Utah to Increase Distribution Rates and Charges and Make Tariff Modifications	<u>DOCKET NO. 25-057-06</u> <u>ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION TO AMEND SCHEDULING ORDER</u>
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ISSUED: September 19, 2025

On May 13, 2025, the Public Service Commission (PSC) issued a Scheduling Order, Notice of Technical Conferences, Notice of Public Witness Hearings, and Notice of Hearings in this docket ("Scheduling Order"). The Scheduling Order bifurcated this docket into Phase I and Phase II and set certain dates that included, as relevant here, a September 23, 2025 deadline for filing Phase I written rebuttal testimony. On September 18, 2025, Enbridge Gas Utah (EGU) filed an Unopposed Motion to Amend Scheduling Order ("Motion").

The Motion represents that EGU and the other parties in this docket – the Division of Public Utilities, the Office of Consumer Services, the Federal Executive Agencies, the Utah Association of Energy Users, the American Natural Gas Council, and Nucor Steel-Utah ("Other Parties") – "[have] engaged in settlement discussions[,] and "[i]n furtherance of pursuing the ongoing settlement discussions, [EGU] requests that the deadline for Phase I Written Rebuttal Testimony be extended to September 26, 2025." The Motion affirms that no other deadlines in the Scheduling Order will be impacted by this request. The Motion further represents the Other Parties do not object to EGU's requested extension.

Good cause appearing, and based on EGU's representations that the Other Parties do not object to the Motion, the Motion is granted as follows:

1. The current deadline of September 23, 2025, for filing Phase I written rebuttal testimony is vacated;
2. The new deadline for filing Phase I written rebuttal testimony is **Friday, September 26, 2025**; and
3. All other dates, times, and locations in the Scheduling Order or other notices issued by the PSC (i.e., the evidentiary hearing and public witness hearings) remain unchanged.
