Questar Gas Company dba Enbridge Gas Utah (“Enbridge”, “EGU” or the “Company”) respectfully moves the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) for leave to allow certain witnesses to appear remotely at the Phase I hearing beginning on October 22, 2025.

In support of this motion, Enbridge states as follows:

1. On May 1, 2025, Enbridge filed the Application in this matter.

2. The other parties to this matter are: the Utah Division of Public Utilities (“Division”), the Utah Office of Consumer Services (“Office”), the Utah Association of Energy Users (“UAE”), the Federal Executive Agencies (“FEA”), the American Natural Gas Council (“ANGC”), and Nucor Steel-Utah, a Division of Nucor Corporation (“Nucor”).

3. On May 13, 2025, the Commission issued the Scheduling Order, Notice of Technical Conferences, Notice of Public Witness Hearings, and Notice of Hearings issued in this matter (“Scheduling Order”). Among other things, the Scheduling Order bifurcated the issues into Phase I and Phase II and set forth dates for testimony and hearings for Phase I and Phase II.

4. On September 16 and 19, 2025, the parties to this matter engaged in settlement discussions regarding Phase I issues. As a result of these good faith, arm’s length negotiations, certain parties reached agreement on all Phase I issues and executed the Phase I Settlement Stipulation. The parties to the Phase I Settlement Stipulation are Enbridge, the Division, the Office, and UAE. FEA, ANGC, and Nucor are not signatories but have confirmed they do not oppose the Phase I Settlement Stipulation.

5. On September 26, 2025, the parties reaching settlement submitted the executed Phase I Settlement Stipulation for the Commission’s approval and adoption. These parties have requested that a hearing on the Phase I Settlement Stipulation be held on October 22, 2025, which is the date originally scheduled for the Phase I hearing.

6. At the hearing, Enbridge, the Division, and the Office each will, and UAE may, make one or more witnesses available to explain and support the Phase I Settlement Stipulation to the Commission. Such witnesses will be available for examination.

7. Numerous witnesses filed testimony on behalf of Enbridge on Phase I issues. Enbridge will have witnesses present in the hearing room to testify during the Phase I hearing, including the primary witness who will explain and support the Phase I Settlement Stipulation on behalf of the Company. A few of Enbridge's witnesses who addressed Phase I issues are located out-of-state. None of these out-of-state witnesses will be presenting testimony regarding the Phase I Settlement Stipulation. As such, Enbridge does not anticipate that there will be examination of these witnesses. If a need should arise to examine one or more of these out-of-state witnesses during the Phase I hearing, Enbridge submits that it would be more cost-efficient for the witness to appear remotely.

8. Enbridge has communicated with the other parties who will participate in the hearing on the Phase I Settlement Stipulation—Division, Office, and UAE—and is authorized to represent that these parties have no objection to this motion.

WHEREFORE, based upon the foregoing, Enbridge Gas Utah respectfully requests that the Commission grant leave to allow its out-of-state witnesses to appear remotely at the Phase I hearing beginning on October 22, 2025.
