ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS TO
PARTICIPATE AND APPEAR REMOTELY

ISSUED: November 14, 2025

The Phase II hearing in this docket is set to commence on November 18, 2025. Nucor Steel-Utah, a division of Nucor Corporation (“Nucor”), filed a motion seeking leave for its witness to appear remotely at this hearing, and to allow certain legal counsel to also appear remotely (“Nucor’s Motion”). The Federal Executive Agencies (“FEA”) filed a similar motion (“FEA’s Motion”). Both motions assert that their respective testifying witnesses, and the identified legal counsel, reside outside of Utah. Both motions also assert that remote participation in this hearing by these witnesses and identified legal counsel will be less costly and more convenient for Nucor and FEA.

While the PSC generally works to accommodate remote participation of non-local witnesses in recognition that it is significantly more convenient and less costly, the PSC prefers that testifying witnesses be present in the hearing room. However, we will make an exception to our preference based, in part, on the representations made in the respective motions. These representations include that each moving party has communicated with the other parties in this docket and confirmed no objection exists for the remote participation of the respective witnesses, or for the remote participation of the identified legal counsel. Moreover, Nucor has specifically

represented that it will have Utah-based legal counsel present in the hearing room, and FEA has similarly represented that it will have legal counsel present in the hearing room.

Accordingly, for good cause shown, the PSC grants Nucor's Motion and the FEA's Motion. The PSC will contact representatives for Nucor and FEA and provide them with instructions regarding remote participation in the Phase II hearings, currently scheduled for November 18, 2025, and if needed, November 19, 2025.
