Re: *Tariff Sheet Compliance Filing, Docket Nos. 25-057-06, Application of Enbridge Gas Utah to Increase Distribution Rates and Charges and Make Tariff Modifications; and Docket No. 25-057-22, Enbridge Gas Utah's Application for Approval of the 2026 Year Budget for Energy Efficiency Programs and Market Transformation Initiative*

Dear Mr. Summers:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Enbridge Gas Utah's ("EGU," formerly Dominion Energy Utah) January 22, 2026, compliance filing of two sets of tariff revisions (the "Tariffs"). First, EGU submitted revisions and associated exhibits reflecting the PSC's December 24, 2025 Order in Docket No. 25-057-06 (the "2025 Order"), approving rates and charges related to the Application of EGU to Increase Distribution Rates and Charges and Make Tariff Modifications. Second, EGU submitted revisions reflecting the PSC's Order in Docket No. 25-057-22 (the "EE & MTI Order"), approving changes to EGU's budget and associated measures related to EGU's Application for Approval of the 2026 Year Budget for Energy Efficiency Programs and Market Transformation Initiative ("EE & MTI").

The PSC also reviewed the Division of Public Utilities' ("DPU") February 9, 2026, comments recommending the PSC acknowledge that the revised Tariffs comply with the 2025 Order and the EE & MTI Order. DPU also states the Tariffs accurately reflect the rates and other changes approved in the 2025 Order, as well as the removal of the "Hydronic Heating Coil" measure from EGU's list of incentives approved in the EE & MTI Order. The DPU further "notes that EGU Attachment 3 – TBF Listing does not contain proof of [PSC] approval of the customers included in the TBF list; however, the

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[DPU] confirmed with [EGU] that the customers included on the list were added [before the requirement for EGU to obtain] [PSC] approval of those customers.”¹

For this filing, EGU’s representation that the Tariffs comply with the 2025 Order, and the filing of the proposed tariff sheets itself, constitute the representation that EGU, in good faith, believes the proposed tariff sheets are consistent with applicable statutes, rules, and other orders.² Regarding the Tariffs, they generally appear to comply with the PSC’s 2025 Order and EE & MTI Order.

Based on the PSC’s review of the compliance filing and DPU’s comments and recommendations, EGU’s Tariff revisions in Docket Nos. 25-057-06 and 25-057-22 are acknowledged as complying with the 2025 Order and the EE & MTI Order.
