The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Enbridge Gas Utah's (EGU) July 1, 2025 filing of its Affiliate Transaction Report for the twelve months ending December 31, 2024 ("Report"). The filing was made pursuant to reporting requirements agreed to by EGU (formerly, Dominion Energy Utah) in paragraph 45 of a settlement stipulation ("Stipulation") adopted by the PSC in its September 14, 2016 Order Memorializing Bench Ruling Approving Settlement Stipulation in Docket No. 16-057-01 ("Order").

The Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed comments on November 25, 2025. The DPU analyzed the Report and associated information to ascertain the degree to which affiliated interests exert substantial influence over EGU's corporate policies and actions. The DPU confirmed that affiliate services were rendered and received both under the Intercompany Administrative Services Agreements (IASA) and outside of these formal agreements.

DPU highlighted the following key findings from its review:

- The IASA-related transactions exhibited no undue positive or negative financial impact on EGU.
- A continued decreasing trend in transactions conducted outside of the IASA framework.
- Active affiliated interest relationships are present.

- EGU provided all requisite affiliate transaction documentation upon request.
- The reported affiliate activity does not appear to be aversive to the public interest.

The DPU further affirmed that the Report complies with both the Stipulation and the Order and therefore recommends the PSC acknowledge the submission.

Based on the review of the Report and the findings and recommendation of the DPU, the PSC acknowledges the Report, confirming its compliance with the requirements set forth in the Stipulation and the Order.
