ISSUED: April 27, 2026

On January 27, 2026, Enbridge Gas Utah (EGU) filed with the Public Service Commission (PSC) a Notice of Intent to File IRP and Request for Scheduling Order and Notice of Technical Conferences. On February 6, 2026, the PSC Issued a Scheduling Order and Notice of Technical Conferences ("Scheduling Order"). The Scheduling Order provides, among other things, that EGU would discuss "New Storage Options" in a Technical Conference on March 3, 2026. However, during that March 3rd Technical Conference EGU discussed new storage options but also indicated that it would provide additional information on this topic in a later technical conference.

On April 9, 2026, EGU filed a Motion to Modify Scheduling Order ("Motion") addressing EGU providing additional information on "New Storage Options." In this regard, the Motion states EGU "had intended to include ... additional information [on this topic] in the Technical Conference scheduled for May 5, 2026[.]" but now represents that "the volume of data intended to be presented [on this topic] does not permit time for a robust discussion of storage options."<sup>1</sup> Thus, the Motion seeks to

modify the Scheduling Order to add an additional technical conference date of May 26, 2026, for purposes of reviewing “New Storage Options.”

Good cause appearing, and there being no opposition, the Motion is granted. As amended, the remaining schedule for this docket is as follows:

To the extent the parties cannot come to an agreement, the parties should submit their dispute to the PSC at the earliest practicable date in advance of the conference.
