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Sierra West Diamonds Corp (“Complainant”) and Enbridge Gas Utah (“Enbridge”) (collectively, the “Parties”), by and through their respective counsel, hereby jointly stipulate and respectfully request that the Utah Public Service Commission (“Commission”) enter an order staying this proceeding and extending Enbridge’s deadline to respond to the Formal Complaint filed on March 12, 2026.

1. On March 12, 2026, Complainant filed a Formal Complaint with the Commission related to gas service at Complainant’s location at 60 East 10600 South, Sandy, UT 84070.
2. On March 13, 2026, the Commission issued its Notice of Filing and Comment Period, allowing Enbridge until April 13, 2026, to submit a written response to the Formal Complaint.
3. Enbridge has not yet filed its responsive pleading to the Formal Complaint.

4. The Parties represent that they are currently engaged in good-faith discussions and are jointly pursuing informal resolution of the issues raised in the Formal Complaint.
5. The Parties believe that a temporary stay of this proceeding will facilitate those efforts, conserve Commission and party resources, and may obviate the need for further proceedings before the Commission.
6. Accordingly, the Parties jointly request:
  - a. That this proceeding be stayed for a period of thirty (30) days, or until May 13, 2026; and
  - b. That Enbridge’s deadline to file its responsive pleading to the Formal Complaint be extended by thirty (30) days, or until May 13, 2026.
7. The Parties agree to promptly notify the Commission if the matter is resolved during the stay period.

WHEREFORE, the Parties respectfully request that the Commission approve this Joint Stipulation, stay the proceeding for thirty (30) days, and extend Enbridge’s response deadline accordingly.
