On March 20, 2026, Enbridge Gas Utah ("EGU") filed its Expedited Motion for Commission Approval to Temporarily Deviate from Utah Natural Gas Tariff No. 800 ("Waiver Motion"). The Waiver Motion seeks approval "to temporarily waive interest charges on past due balances of mail-in payments from Utah customers that are late between April 10, 2026 and June 30, 2026 due to [EGU's] transition to a new payment remittance center." EGU seeks an expedited determination of the Waiver Motion because it seeks to commence this transition on or before April 10, 2026.

Any interested person may submit comments on the Waiver Motion on or before **Wednesday, April 1, 2026**, and may submit reply comments on or before **Friday, April 3, 2026**.
