Re: *Review of the Carrying Charges Applied to Various Enbridge Gas Utah Account Balances*; Docket No. 26-057-T01

Dear Ms. Clark:

The Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) reviewed the February 23, 2026 filing by Enbridge Gas Utah (EGU) proposing changes to Section 8.07, Calculation of Carrying Charge ("Carrying Charge") of its Utah Natural Gas Tariff No. 800 ("Tariff"). EGU proposes to revise Page 1 of Section 8.07 to increase the current effective Carrying Charge from 5.40 percent to 5.68 percent.<sup>1</sup>

EGU filed the Tariff revisions consistent with the PSC's order approving Carrying Charges in Docket No. 17-057-T01 ("Carrying Charge Order").<sup>2</sup> EGU requests an effective date of April 1, 2026.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on March 9, 2026 ("DPU Comments") and EGU's reply comments, filed on March 17, 2026 ("EGU Reply Comments"). DPU reviewed and confirmed that EGU's calculations of the Carrying Charge were correct and recommends the PSC approve

the revised Carrying Charge as filed, effective April 1, 2026. According to EGU's Reply Comments, EGU concurs with DPU's findings and acknowledges DPU's efforts in ensuring the proposed rate is correct, and in the public interest. Additionally, EGU notes that DPU recommends "the [PSC] approve [EGU's] proposed changes to its Utah Natural Gas tariff 600, section 8.07."<sup>3</sup> EGU states that DPU cites the tariff incorrectly and "recommends the [PSC] approve EGU's Tariff 800, Section 8.07."<sup>4</sup>

Based on the PSC's review of EGU's filing, DPU Comments, and the EGU Reply Comments and there being no opposition, the proposed revisions to Page 1 of Section 8.07 of the Tariff are approved, effective April 1, 2026.
