FINAL ORDER

ISSUED: April 1, 2003

By The Commission:

On June 8, 2001, Questar Gas Company (QGC or the Company) filed with the Commission an application requesting rate changes that result in a zero impact for the typical residential customer using 115 decatherms annually. The application explains that, although the Account No. 191 amortization needs to be increased to recover the large under-collected balance, purchased gas prices have decreased allowing for stable rates at this time.

The Division of Public Utilities (DPU) reviewed the Company's application and recommended in its June 29, 2001, Memorandum that the application be approved on an interim basis and that the proposed rates be effective July 1, 2001. On March 26, the DPU submitted a final recommendation noting that its review was complete and recommending that the interim rates be made final. No objection to that recommendation has been made.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The interim rates made effective July 1, 2001, are made final.
