REPORT AND ORDER

By The Commission:

Complainant filed its formal complaint in this matter on June 28, 2002. Questar Gas responded with an Answer and Motion to Dismiss on August 6, 2002. Questar's motion was denied by an order dated September 4, 2002, and a hearing set. A hearing was held on November 5, 2002. After the hearing the parties requested that the Commission delay its ruling so that they could discuss settlement of the matter. Questar Gas has recently informed the Commission that the matter has been settled to the satisfaction of both parties.

On the basis that this matter has been settled, we enter the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

1. The Complaint of Superior Air Handling Corporation against Questar Gas Company is dismissed.
2. If any party wishes to proceed further, it may file a written petition for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure to do so will forfeit the right to appeal.
