ORDER

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ISSUED: February 23, 2004

By The Commission:

On December 4, 2003, Questar Gas Company (QGC) filed an Application proposing adjustments to the commodity and supplier non-gas cost portions of its Utah natural gas rates. The net effect of the proposed adjustments would have resulted in an \$11,929,000 decrease in revenues. Since the filing of the application, prices for natural gas supplies have changed and vary from those used in the Application. On December 23, 2003, QGC proposed that the Commission suspend the application and the proposed rate change pending further examination of changing natural gas prices. On February 13, 2004, QGC filed an Amended Application. In its February filing, the company now proposes to keep rates at their current levels, as actual and projected cost and revenue levels tracked by the 191 Account indicate that no rate changes are needed. On February 18, 2004, the Division of Public Utilities submitted its comments on QGC's February Amended Application, concurring with the company's position.

Based thereon, the Commission enters this ORDER approving QGC's February Amended Application. Wherefore, the rates previously implemented in accordance with Docket No. 03-057-01, effective October 1, 2003, will remain in effect and will not be changed as a result of the application filed in this docket.
