PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On August 4, 1999, Questar Gas Company (QGC) applied for modification of its Transportation Nomination Schedule to change the daily deadline for orders from 11:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. QGC justified the application on the basis that the change brought QGC's Schedule into conformance with the Gas Industry Standards Board standard, brought QGC into Y2K compliance more economically, and increased convenience for customers in that they could avoid having to enter online orders through two different programs. On August 30, 1999, the Division of Public Utilities, Utah Department of Commerce, filed with the Commission a memorandum recommending approval. In the meantime, no protest from customers emerged. No detriment to the public interest appearing, we have determined to dispose of the matter without further proceedings, and accordingly, we enter the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The Application be, and it is, granted.
- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure to do so will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
