I received your email address after contacting the Utah Public Service Commission. I understand that the new 385 area-code overlay was approved in July of 2007. I regret that I was not aware of this change and did not have an opportunity to express my concerns. I was told I could voice my concerns at this email address.

I would like to understand why you chose to add the 385 area code to the 801 calling area rather than split the 801 area into one-half 801 and one-half 385. I have lived in other states and had family in other states that have added new area codes. A portion of the people had their area code changed, but after the year's time to notify others of the change, they were able to carry on dialing the local 7 digit numbers. I find it quite an inconvenience to call the 10 digit number for each and every call that I make. I was told that adding the new 385 area code to the 801 would impact less, but in my eyes, it impacts more in the long term. Is there any way for the commission to reconsider their decision?
