By The Commission:

On November 19, 2009, the Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) filed with the Utah Public Service Commission a recommendation regarding the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act (“PURPA”) Electric Standard No. 17 – Rate Design Modification to Promote Energy Efficiency Investments (“Standard No. 17” or “Rate Design Standard”) enacted by the 2007 Energy Independence and Security Act. In its recommendation, the Division concluded the Commission should not adopt the Rate Design Standard because current rate designs and demand-side management (“DSM”) activities in Utah are in line with the requirements of Standard No. 17 and any modification to current rate designs need to be made in a rate case setting.
