Re: Docket No. 08-999-05 – Report on summary level inventory of current “home energy reports”

On December 17, 2009, in the above referenced docket, the Commission directed the DSM advisory group to review the concept of a “home energy report” and provide a recommendation to the Commission whether such a report is appropriate for Rocky Mountain Power’s Utah service territory. The Commission directed such recommendation be provided to the Commission by May 1, 2010. On April 8, 2010, Rocky Mountain Power filed a letter with the Commission requesting an extension of the due date of this report from May 1, 2010 to February 28, 2011. In support of this request, the Company stated it is currently in an open procurement process for “home energy report” type products and as such, procurement policy and confidentiality considerations would make it difficult for the Company to engage in meaningful open exchanges of information with these vendors outside of the immediate procurement efforts. In addition, the Company also indicated that being in an open procurement process makes it challenging for the Company to lead an exploratory effort with the DSM advisory group until such time as we complete the evaluation of our outstanding proposals. The Division of Public Utilities supported the Company’s request in a memorandum to the Commission submitted in this docket dated April 21, 2010.

In the April 8, 2010 letter to the Commission, the Company offered to submit a report which provides a summary level inventory of known “home energy reports” that are currently being provided to electric utility customers in the United States to the Commission by May 1, 2010. Pursuant to this commitment, the Company provides herewith a report which summarizes the “home energy reports” currently being provided by utilities to their customers in the United States.
