Dear Commissioners,

Park City Municipal Corporation supports efforts to make information on energy use, rates, and generation easily accessible for its residents. Improved access to this information will facilitate better consumer decisions and provide numerous environmental and economic benefits.

The Home Energy Report Review filed by Rocky Mountain Power on February 28, 2011 shows promise as a program to empower residents to become more active in energy conservation. Park City has a high level of interest in programs such as these which enhance our local greenhouse gas mitigation efforts and work in parallel with energy efficiency and conservation programs we currently offer. Furthermore, we agree with the comments submitted by Utah Clean Energy on March 14, 2011 regarding the Smart Grid Information Standard and Home Energy Report.

Park City supports development of a Home Energy Report program as well as distribution of the information contained in the Smart Grid Information Standard to *all* Rocky Mountain Power customers. Providing this information will improve public understanding of energy issues and spur efficiency and conservation activities among residents. Given that the Commission found that much of the information needed to implement the smart grid information standard is already available, we think it is reasonable for Rocky Mountain Power to make “smart grid” information convenient for all its customers to access.

We are highly interested in Rocky Mountain Power’s ongoing efforts to track and investigate smart grid pilot programs and development projects. Learning from these programs and projects will assist with eventually implementing applications that improve environmental sustainability and ensure our ability to integrate future, effective technologies into our energy infrastructure.
