**RECOMMENDATION:**

The Division recommends the Commission request Salt Lake County to approve the proposed project which complies with the ordinances and state law administered by the Public Service Commission to operate in Utah.

**EXPLANATION:**

The Division has reviewed and researched the request from Salt Lake County Planning and Development Services Division regarding Project Application No. 25372 for the single-family dwelling to be built at 936 No Pioneer Ford Road in Emigration Canyon. The Division has verified that the public water system, which the property will connect to, is Emigration Improvement District (EID). The EID is not under the jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission of Utah, since the Salt Lake County Commission created it in 1968. The Division of Drinking Water does have jurisdiction because the EID serves more than 15 connections or 25 persons.
