RECOMMENDATION:

The Division recommends the Public Service Commission of Utah request Salt Lake County to approve the proposed project referenced above which complies with the ordinances and state law administered by the Public Service Commission to operate in Utah.

EXPLANATION:

The Division has reviewed and researched the request from Salt Lake County Planning and Development Services Division regarding Project Application No. 25301 for the single-family dwelling to be built near 2160 South Mount Aire Road in Parleys Canyon. The Division has verified that the public water system, which the property will connect to, is Birch Springs Nonprofit Private Water Corporation. Birch Springs Nonprofit Private Water Corporation applied for a Letter of Exemption with the Public Service Commission of Utah on August 4, 2010 which the Commission issued on October 13, 2010. Birch Springs Nonprofit Private Water Corporation does not have an approved water system with the Division of Drinking Water because it currently serves 10 connections. The Division of Drinking Water will have jurisdiction if it serves more than 15 connections or 25 persons.
