On August 22, 2012, Anderson Geneva, LLC filed a request for additional time to pursue settlement of this matter. Anderson Geneva reports it continues to conduct meaningful settlement discussions with both the Utah Transit Authority and Union Pacific Railroad regarding the crossing on which this controversy centers. Anderson Geneva requests an additional extension of time of 90 days to continue efforts to conclude this matter. Anderson Geneva states the other parties in this matter, Vineyard Town, Utah Department of Transportation, and Utah Transit Authority consent to the extension.

The request for extended time to pursue settlement is granted. If a settlement has not been reached by December 1, 2012, Anderson Geneva shall file with the Commission, on or before that date, a further report of the status of negotiations.
