RE: Review and audit of Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) Demand Side Management (DSM) Program.

Purpose

As part of the Division of Public Utilities (Division) ongoing mission of providing a balance between the public interest and utilities, the Division will be performing an audit of the DSM Program for the calendar year 2010.

Background

Projects included in the DSM program include Irrigation Load Control Program, Cool Keeper Program, Energy Star New Homes Program, Home Energy Savings Incentive Program, Cool Cash Incentive Program, See ya later, refrigerator® Recycling Program, FinAnswer Express Program, Energy FinAnswer Program, Low Income Weatherization Program, Recommissioning Program and the Self Direction Program.

Issue

Annually the Division reviews various programs for compliance with state energy regulation and tariffs. Rocky Mountain Power's DSM program was chosen for review at this time. The review will entail a sampling of invoices from the DSM 193 account for the 12 months ended 2010 and a review of the program administration.
