Dear PCS -

I, like many of my neighbors, have been outraged to hear recently that our Heber Light and Power Board of Directors, most of whom make less than \$500 a month as board members for a decidedly part time role, recently (November 2011) voted themselves full health care benefits with a value that far exceeds their monthly salaries - a benefit hardly any part time worker receives in the private sector and an affront to those of us who experienced a rate increase last year just so they could line their pockets. Their health care will apparently cost more than 20% of the increase!

Apparently one of the few board member who would have stood up against this was not informed of this being a topic up for vote on an unusual occasion where he had to miss a meeting. His strong opposition to this vote appears now to have resulted in his dismissal from the board.

I would like the public services commission to look into the legal and ethical obligations of the board, especially given the relatively recent transition of our utilities in Timberlakes to this entity, and let me know what recourse if any we may have. I would like to see this coverage repealed and I would like to see Alan McDonald put back on the board as he is one of so few that appear to be looking out for the interests of the customers/citizens. Other than that, I will exercise my right to vote as many of the offending board members out of office as possible in the future.

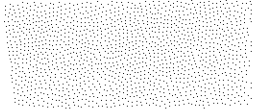
