You make clear you do not regulate municipally owned power companies such as Heber Light and Power. Many customers of Heber Light and Power feel that they should be subject to your oversight. It has come to light that the board members, largely elected officials, are paying themselves way in excess of any definition of reasonable compensation estimated now to be \$1400 and our for work that probably should be done by appointed officials with come expertise in power generation to begin with. This was recently documented in the Salt Lake Tribune by Christopher Smart and by many articles in the Wasatch Wave. It is now clear that the two recent rate increases should could have been either eliminated or reduced had not this obscenely self serving compensation been adjusted to a reasonable limit.

There is now a petition circulating to complain but that petition will have little influence. There is another effort to approach Rocky Mountain Power to investigate switching service.

All of these points suggest the need for additional oversight and I beg you to take this on.
