On July 24, 2012 CenturyLink notified the Commission that it accepted Connect America Fund (CAF) Phase I incremental support for 2012 that it would use to deploy broadband to unserved locations in Utah. At that time, CenturyLink stated that it would provide additional data for those locations, including latitude and longitude within one year of the date of that letter. CenturyLink is now providing that information.

Attachment A identifies, by 2010 Census Block FIPS code, wire center CLLI code, NECA Company Code (OCN), Study Area Code, latitude and longitude, the locations in Utah to which CenturyLink will deploy (or has deployed) broadband using the accepted CAF Phase I incremental support.
