**Re: Notice of Non-Competitive Procurement with Emerson Process Management Power & Water Solutions, Inc.**

Commissioners:

In accordance with PacifiCorp's Procurement Policy, the Company must report to the Commission purchases of goods or services exceeding \$500,000 that are not competitively bid. This letter hereby serves as notice that, on June 2, 2015, PacifiCorp entered into a non-competitively bid release pursuant to a master general services contract with Emerson Process Management Power & Water Solutions, Inc. ("Emerson Process Management"), which exceeds \$500,000. The release for this scope of work has a projected cost of \$545,940.

Pursuant to PacifiCorp's Procurement Policy, a supplier may be awarded a contract on a non-competitive basis under certain circumstances, such as when competitive bidding is impossible or impractical, or when otherwise a non-competitive procurement has been demonstrated to be in the best interest of the Company. Accordingly, the release entered into by PacifiCorp with Emerson Process Management was justified. Under the release terms, Emerson Process Management will perform work and furnish equipment to upgrade the Company's existing Ovation distributed control system at its Huntington Plant Unit 2. The Company had identified Emerson Process Management as the sole supplier that could perform the upgrade at this location because of the proprietary nature of the software and systems.
