Commissioners:

Colorado Interstate Natural Gas Company, L.L.C. ("CIG") tenders for filing and acceptance by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") Part I: Overview, Section 3 – System Map, Version 5.0.0 for inclusion in its FERC Gas Tariff, Second Revised Volume No. 1 ("Tariff") to become effective May 1, 2015.

Reason for Filing

On November 20, 2014 the Commission issued its Final Rule in Docket No. RM14-21-000 amending its regulations at §18 C.F.R.154.103 and 154.106 to permanently eliminate the requirements that pipelines include system maps in their tariffs and file updates to system maps by April 30 of any year following a major system change ("Final Rule" or "Order No. 801").¹ In lieu of including and updating system maps in pipeline tariffs, the Final Rule required pipelines to maintain a system map on their internet websites. The Final Rule also directed pipelines to update their online system maps no later than the end of the next calendar quarter after a major system change.²

Currently, CIG's Tariff includes a system map in Part I: Overview, Section 3 – System Map. In compliance with the Final Rule, CIG is modifying the tariff section to remove the system map and insert a statement informing readers that the system map is posted on CIG's interactive website. The tariff record will also include an internet address to CIG's Informational Postings website which links to the system map.

Description of Filing

CIG is submitting this filing pursuant to Subpart C of Part 154 and the Final Rule³ of the Commission's regulations to comply with the Commission's directives as discussed earlier.

Part I: Overview, Section 3 – System Map is updated to remove the system map and to inform readers that a system map can be found on CIG's interactive website. An internet address directing readers to the system map displayed on the website is also included.⁴

Procedural Matters

Inasmuch as this filing is fully described in this transmittal letter, the statement of the nature, the reasons and the basis for the instant tariff filing required by Section 154.7(a)(6) of the Commission's regulations is omitted.

In accordance with the applicable provisions of Part 154 of the Commission's regulations, CIG is submitting the following:

- a) an eTariff XML filing package containing the revised tariff record in electronic format;
- b) a transmittal letter;
- c) clean and marked versions of the tariff sections in PDF format.

CIG respectfully requests that the Commission accept the tendered tariff record for filing and permit it to become effective on May 1, 2015, in accordance with the Final Rule. With respect to any tariff provision the Commission allows to go into effect without change, CIG hereby moves to place the tendered tariff record into effect at the end of the suspension period, if any, specified in a Commission order.

Additionally, pursuant to Section 154.7(a)(7) of the Commission's regulations, CIG respectfully requests that the Commission grant all necessary waivers in order to effectuate this filing.

⁴ The map that will be displayed on CIG's interactive website reflects CIG's system as of December 31, 2014. The system map currently included in the Tariff will be used on the website. No major changes to CIG's system have occurred since that map was accepted by the Commission and incorporated into CIG's Tariff. See Letter Order issued in Docket No. RP14-811-000 on May 22, 2014. Additionally, consistent with Order No. 801 and revised 18 CFR§154.106(c), CIG will reflect any major change to its system on the online map no later than the end of the calendar quarter that immediately follows the calendar quarter in which the major change occurred.

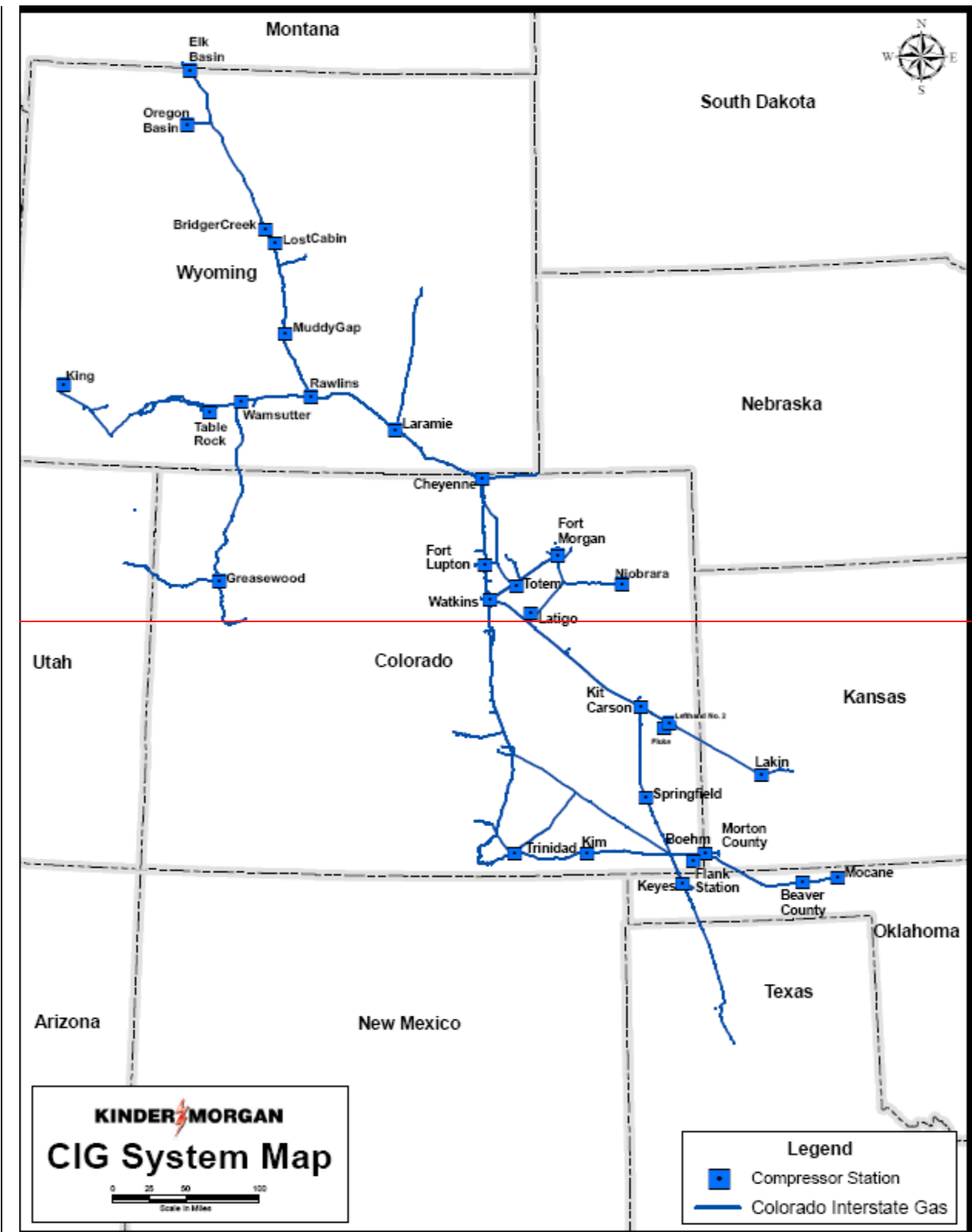
