Attached for your information is the latest status report on the Utah Universal Service Fund and the Speech/Hearing-Impaired Fund. All reported amounts are proprietary.

The Universal Service Fund showed a balance of \$5,743,452 at the end of January, which was an increase of \$546,354 from the previous month. USF disbursements for the month totaled \$742,925. There were no Lifeline reimbursements. Revenues for January totaled \$1,289,280. The fund balance has ranged between \$4.6 and \$5.7 million for the last 12 months.

During the month of January, the Speech/Hearing-Impaired Fund had expenditures of \$59,061. This total includes \$40,276 for professional and technical services, \$1,185 for operating supplies and maintenance, \$480 for travel reimbursement. The fund balance at the end of January was \$3,716,778. This fund balance has generally declined slightly each month since October 2006 when it was at a high of \$4.4 million. The high and low fund balances for the past 12 months were \$4.1 and \$3.7 million respectively. Expenditures from this fund are used primarily for the training and education of interpreters and to provide special telephone equipment for the hearing impaired.
