Re: Notice of Non-Competitive Procurement with Eastern Idaho Community Action Partnership

Commissioners:

In accordance with PacifiCorp's Procurement Policy, the Company must report to the Commission purchases of goods or services exceeding \$500,000 that are not competitively bid. This letter hereby serves as notice that, on March 22, 2016, PacifiCorp entered into a non-competitively bid amendment to a contract with Eastern Idaho Community Action Partnership ("EICAP"), which exceeds \$500,000. The amendment serves to extend the term of the contract and has a projected cost of \$1.25 million.

Pursuant to PacifiCorp's Procurement Policy, a supplier may be awarded a contract on a non-competitive basis under certain circumstances, such as when competitive bidding is impossible or impractical, or when otherwise a non-competitive procurement has been demonstrated to be in the best interest of the Company. Accordingly, the contract amendment entered into by PacifiCorp with EICAP was justified. EICAP currently provides weatherization services to qualifying PacifiCorp customers as detailed in the Company's Low Income Weatherization Program tariff approved by the Idaho Public Utilities Commission. This amendment to the agreement with EICAP ensures a continuity of service from EICAP through March 31, 2021.
