## Recommendation (No Action)

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) submits to the Public Service Commission of Utah (Commission) its findings to the supplemental information requested by PUETIC committee.

## Issue

On October 31, 2024, the Commission submitted its annual UUSF report to the PUETIC committee, in accordance with UCA 54-8b-15(16). The PUETIC committee requested supplemental information to include the following:

1. The number of customers served by each of the companies that receive UUSF funding.
2. The types of services (supported with the UUSF funding) provided by these companies.
3. The miles of network deployed and speeds available (supported with the UUSF funding).

4. Where in these companies' service territory (the companies that receive UUSF funding), are they still using wireline services?

## **Background**

On November 18, 2024, the Commission issued an action request to the Division to obtain additional information to supplement the Commission's October 31, 2024, committee report. Although the request seemed to be directed to the fifteen telecommunication companies recommended for UUSF distributions in 2025, all eighteen telecommunication companies that are required to file annual reports with the Commission and who are potentially eligible to receive UUSF funding were contacted via email and requested to provide the answers the Commission sought. The companies responded via email and provided the information requested.

## **Conclusion**

The Division has concluded its efforts to provide the requested supplemental information. Responses from all eighteen telecommunication companies are attached.
