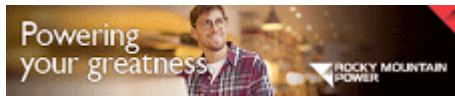
Rocky Mountain Power has an plans to upgrade a portion of our transmission system in the Draper-South Jordan region of the Salt Lake area, and I wanted to send you this information just so you are aware of the project. We will rebuild the existing 46 kV transmission line from the South Jordan substation tap to 114th South to double circuit 138 kV, and will rebuild the 46 kV line from 114th South to Draper substation from 46kV to 138 kV. The project will also include upgrades to the Draper substation including the installation of two 138-13.2 kV 30 MVA transformers. We have a very robust outreach plan that includes door-to-door contact with affected customers, public open house meetings, and city council presentations. Attached is some information on the project including the description and the project schedule (essentially spring 2019 through May 2020). I've also attached a letter we sent our customers in that area informing them of the project and the public open house. Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns.
