SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION

BroadSoft Adaption, Inc. (“BroadSoft Adaption”) through its undersigned counsel and pursuant to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.71 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, hereby submits this application to discontinue the provision of SIP Advantage, an enterprise VoIP service.

As required by Section 63.71(a) and (b) of the Commission’s rules, BroadSoft Adaption provides the following information in support of its application:

1. Name and address of carrier

2. Date of planned service discontinuance

BroadSoft Adaption plans to no longer offer SIP Advantage service to new customers, and to discontinue service to existing non-term customers, on November 14, 2018 subject to regulatory approval. For existing customers that hold term agreements, BroadSoft Adaption plans to discontinue SIP Advantage service on November 14, 2018

service will not adversely affect the public convenience and necessity, and the public will not be harmed by the discontinuance. Customers have been given notice that affords them ample opportunity to acquire reasonable substitute service which is readily available from other providers.

Pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, BroadSoft Adaption is submitting a copy of this application via U.S. Mail to the public utility commissions and to the governors of all U.S. states and the District of Columbia, and to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications for the Secretary of Defense, concurrent with the filing of this application.

CONCLUSION

BroadSoft Adaption respectfully requests that the Commission approve this Section 63.71 application to discontinue the provision of SIP Advantage service.

BroadSoft Adaption, Inc. is sending this message to key contacts at [CUSTOMER] regarding important changes to your SIP Advantage service.

This is an important notice about the discontinuance of your SIP Advantage service.

BroadSoft Adaption, Inc. has provided you with enterprise VoIP service branded under the name SIP Advantage. However, as we have previously notified you, BroadSoft Adaption intends to no longer offer, and to discontinue, SIP Advantage service in all U.S. states and the District of Columbia on November 14, 2018. If you are on a term agreement, BroadSoft Adaption will continue to provide you with SIP Advantage service until November 14, 2018 or the expiration of your term agreement, whichever is later. Existing term agreements will not be renewed or extended.

The Federal Communications Commission* ("FCC") will normally authorize this proposed discontinuance of service unless it is shown that customers would be unable to receive service or a reasonable substitute from another carrier or that the public convenience and necessity is otherwise adversely affected. If you wish to object, you should file your comments as soon as possible, but no later than 15 days after the Commission releases public notice of the proposed discontinuance. You may file your comments electronically through the FCC's Electronic Comment Filing System using the docket number established in the Commission's public notice for this proceeding, or you may address them to the Federal Communications Commission, Wireline Competition Bureau, Competition Policy Division, Washington, DC 20554, and include in your comments a reference to the § 63.71 Application of BroadSoft Adaption, Inc. Comments should include specific information about the impact of this proposed discontinuance upon you or your company, including any inability to acquire reasonable substitute service.

We regret any inconvenience this may cause, and hope that you will continue to take advantage of other BroadSoft services in the future.
