The Division of Public Utilities (Division) has reviewed and conducted a desk audit of the semi-annual report for Virgin Mobile USA, LP (Company), pursuant to Rule R746-8-403 2)(a), for the period of July 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019. The desk audit included a review of the amount and numbers submitted on the Request for Utah Lifeline Discount Reimbursement form, a

comparison to previous reports, and a review of information received from the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC).

Conclusion

The Division finds that the amounts claimed by the Company to be reasonable and justified. The Company is in compliance with the FCC federal requirements and the Commission's requirements for the Lifeline program.
