On November 25, 2019, the Public Service Commission (PSC) received a request for arbitration, indicating Gold's Landscaping ("Gold's") sought arbitration relating to damaged lines of Utopia Fiber at the residence of homeowner Mike Mower pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 54-8a-13.

The PSC provides administrative support to the Underground Facilities Damage Dispute Board ("Board"). In that role, the PSC issued a Notice Regarding Request for Arbitration ("Notice") on November 26, 2019, asking interested parties to submit additional information regarding the dispute, including whether the parties agree to arbitration, to the PSC by December 16, 2019. Accordingly, the PSC gives notice it does not intend to forward the request for arbitration to the Board until and unless it receives an indication that the parties agree to arbitration.
