Mr. Zadeh:

Pursuant to 192.805, Dominion Energy Utah/Wyoming/Idaho (DEUWI) is writing to inform you of modifications made to the Company Operator Qualification (OQ) Plan. Dominion Energy began using a new system, ITS, for OQ program management for both employees and contractors in 2020. The new DEUWI OQ Plan will be effective January 2021. A new plan will be provided to Utah Pipeline Safety at the beginning of 2021.

Modifications to the OQ Plan include the same OQ Task List and OQ program management system for employees and contractors, migration of previous tasks to a new OQ Task List consistent with ASME B31Q, carryover of three Company-specific tasks (Bypassing Meter (Hot Change), CNG Trailer Operation and Maintenance, and Victaulic Coupling Installation and Maintenance), a change in requalification intervals, and span of control to be consistent with B31Q.
