On May 4, 2021, the Public Service Commission (PSC) issued a Notice of Requested Technical Conference, requesting PacifiCorp present a technical conference to address any potential economic or reliability implications to its Utah customers as a result of rule changes the California Independent System Operator approved on April 21, 2021. The PSC requested PacifiCorp contact the PSC to propose a date and time for the conference.

PacifiCorp subsequently provided a list of proposed dates and times for the technical conference. PacifiCorp also requested the technical conference be closed to the public to protect against disclosure of confidential information.

The PSC has found presentation of this information to regulators is in the public interest and expects the presentation to include discussion of confidential information pertaining to wholesale market transactions and other sensitive data. Therefore, the PSC determines it is in the public interest to close the technical conference to the public for the purpose of allowing PacifiCorp's regulators to obtain the information. *See* Utah Code Ann. § 54-3-21(4).

Accordingly, the PSC gives notice it will hold a confidential, virtual technical conference in this docket on **Wednesday**, **May 26**, **2021 at 3:00 p.m.** Attendance at the technical conference will be limited to designated representatives of the PSC, PacifiCorp, the Division of Public Utilities, and the Office of Consumer Services. Each of these parties must submit a list of representatives that will attend the technical conference to the PSC no later than **Monday**, **May**
