Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to section 205 of the Federal Power Act (“FPA”), 16 U.S.C. § 824d, and Section 35.15 of the Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”), 18 C.F.R. § 35.15, and Order No. 714<sup>1</sup> regarding electronic filing of tariff submittals, PacifiCorp hereby notifies the Commission that it is terminating PacifiCorp Rate Schedule No. 733, a Project Construction Agreement (“Agreement”) between Utah Associated Municipal Power Systems (“UAMPS”) and PacifiCorp (“Notice of Termination”).

## **1. Background and Reason for Filing**

The Agreement set forth the design, installation and construction work to be performed by UAMPS and PacifiCorp to accommodate UAMPS’ request for a second point of delivery (the “Project”) under the Fourth Amended and Restated Transmission Service and Operating Agreement (“TSOA”) for Heber Light and Power (“HLP”). On June 1, 2018, PacifiCorp filed the Agreement with the Commission, in Docket No. ER18-1733. The Agreement was designated as PacifiCorp Rate Schedule No. 733. The Commission accepted the filing on July 13, 2018, via letter order, effective August 1, 2018.

After repeated scope changes, ultimately the decision was made to no longer pursue the Project. On June 8, 2021 PacifiCorp and UAMPS mutually agreed to terminate the Agreement. Accordingly, PacifiCorp now provides this Notice of Termination.

## **2. Effective Date**

In accordance with 18 C.F.R. § 35.15(a) of the Commission’s regulations, PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the termination become effective September 6, 2021. September 6, 2021 is ninety (90) days from when PacifiCorp and UAMPS mutually agreed to terminate the Agreement.
