Notice of Termination

Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to section 205 of the Federal Power Act (“FPA”), 16 U.S.C. § 824d, and Section 35.15 of the Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”), 18 C.F.R. § 35.15, and Order No. 714¹ regarding electronic filing of tariff submittals, PacifiCorp hereby notifies the Commission that it is terminating PacifiCorp Rate Schedule No. 727, a Construction Agreement (“Agreement”) between City of Lehi (“Lehi”) and PacifiCorp (“Notice of Termination”).

1. Background and Reason for Filing

The Agreement set forth the design, installation, and construction work to be performed by Lehi and PacifiCorp to accommodate Lehi’s request to recommission the Lehi City Spring Creek Point of Interconnection. On March 2, 2017, PacifiCorp filed the Agreement with the Commission, in Docket No. ER17-1091. The Agreement was designated as PacifiCorp Rate Schedule No. 727. The Commission accepted the filing on April 25, 2017, via letter order, effective May 2, 2017.

Section 1 (Term), of the Agreement states, in relevant part, that the Agreement “...shall terminate ninety (90) days after receipt of final payment of actual costs by Lehi”. On August 23, 2021 PacifiCorp received final payment from Lehi. Accordingly, PacifiCorp now seeks to terminate the Agreement pursuant to its own terms.

2. Effective Date

In accordance with 18 C.F.R. § 35.15(a) of the Commission’s regulations, PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the termination become effective November 21, 2021. November 21, 2021 is ninety (90) days from PacifiCorp’s receipt of final payment from Lehi, and, as discussed above, is the date that the Agreement will terminate according to its own terms.
