RE: *PacifiCorp* Docket No. ER22-_____-000 Notice of Termination

Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to section 205 of the Federal Power Act ("FPA"), 16 U.S.C. § 824d, and Section 35.15 of the Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission"), 18 C.F.R. § 35.15, and Order No. 714¹ regarding electronic filing of tariff submittals, PacifiCorp hereby notifies the Commission that it is terminating PacifiCorp Rate Schedule No. 730, a Project Construction Agreement ("Agreement") between Utah Associated Municipal Power Systems ("UAMPS") and PacifiCorp.

1. Background and Reason for Filing

On June 7, 2017, PacifiCorp and UAMPS entered into the Agreement. UAMPS requested additional capacity at the temporary interconnection tap off of PacifiCorp's 12.5 kV distribution line to serve its loads. The Agreement set forth the construction and coordination work to be performed by UAMPS and PacifiCorp to accommodate UAMPS request. On June 16, 2017, PacifiCorp filed the Agreement with the Commission, in Docket No. ER17-1846. The Agreement was designated as PacifiCorp Rate Schedule No. 730. The Commission accepted the filing on August 1, 2017, via letter order, effective August 16, 2017.

Section 2 (Term) of the agreement states, in relevant part, that the Agreement "...shall terminate ninety (90) days following: Company's refund of overpayment to Customer, pursuant to Section 4 of this Agreement. On October 19, 2021 PacifiCorp issued a refund to UAMPS via wire. Accordingly, PacifiCorp now seeks to terminate the Agreement.

2. Effective Date

In accordance with 18 C.F.R. § 35.15(a) of the Commission's regulations, PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the termination become effective January 17, 2022. January 17, 2022 is ninety (90) days from date PacifiCorp issued refund.
