Dear Information Resources Manager:

I hope this finds you doing well. Per DOT Part 192.805 and 195.505, this communication is to notify PHMSA that Kinder Morgan (OP ID 18092) has changed the span of control (SOC) for tasks listed below. These changes are the result of subject matter expert (SME) reviews that resulted in a reduction of the SOC for each task:

- 24.03.01: Nondestructive Testing of Welds reduced from 1:3 to 1:0
- 103.09 – Non-Destructive Testing of Welds reduced from 1:3 to 1:0
- 104.10 - Inspection of Support Structures on Existing Aboveground Components reduced from 1:4 to 1:2
- 104.04 - Place and Maintain Permanent Line Markers reduced from 1:4 to 1:2
- 102.11 - Atmospheric Corrosion – Application of Coatings reduced from 1:5 to 1:2

Changes are effective October 1, 2021. This will affect natural gas and hazardous liquids pipelines operated by Kinder Morgan subject to the OQ program. These assets are present in all PHMSA regions. Kinder Morgan's Natural Gas Covered Task List, Hazardous Liquids Covered Task list and Kinder Morgan's Liquid Terminals Covered Task list are attached. Changes indicated in this notice are highlighted in yellow on in attachments. Please contact me if there are any questions.
