Gross Negligence of Taylorsville Bennion when installing new water line.


Buried and left abandoned line right above active line. Abandoned line was located above active line within 2' making it more likely to find the abandoned line then active line when potholing the water utility marks. See photo below (Note: When Bennion Taylorsville discovered this line an employee by the name of Karl removed the abandoned line from the damaged area then crushed it immediately with an excavator,





Thrust block encased an 8ft+ area of pipe encasing a large portion of the line with concrete makes the line far more brittle and susceptible to break when any additional utility is to be installed in the area See photo below of specifications of Udot roads and what was installed: Additional pictures and videos are available





When Taylorsville Bennion updated there line, the excavated road was then buried along with new line. Leaving extremely large pieces of asphalt much larger then the line itself surrounding the line on both sides. This makes it extremely likely to damage this line for any company going below this line. See pictures of asphalt discovered during excavation. Additional pictures and videos are available.

07-14-2021:

Employee Locates and marks water line depth at 52"

07-15-2021

Approximately 9:00 A.M:

drill operator mentioned to locator he was running into a rough, rocky area just before the potholed water line.

Locator stops operator to verify depth of potholed utility (52") and debt of bore head (77").

Approximately 9:20 A.M

Water line burst



Approximately 9:40 A.M

Taylorsville Bennion Arrived onsite

Approximately 9:50 A.M

Water was shut off

Barricades Services was called for an emergency, barricades to be placed blocking 3 southbound lanes on Redwood Rd and merging the 3 northbound lanes to allow southbound traffic to continue through. Along with barricades to close of west bound traffic completely on 4200 south




Approximately 10:30 A.M

Taylorsville Bennion's Hydrovacc arrives onsite to remove water

Taylorsville Bennion's Excavator arrives onsite to remove material to see damaged area.

Dominion Energy is called to shut off Gas line running near the damaged area for precaution while removing damaged road.



Approximately 10:50 A.M

Outer coating of gas line is damaged by Taylorsville Bennions excavator operator.

Approximately 11:20-11:45 A.M

Abandoned Water line located above and just slightly west of active water line. (Note we believe this was the line located during our potholeing.)

Old water line was removed from damaged area by Taylorsville Bennion and placed behind excavated material. This line was repeatably smashed by the excavator destroying the old line before any measurement could be taken.







Approximately 12:00-12:45 PM

Outer coating is repaired on gas line





Approximately 12:45-1:30 P.M

Taylorsville Bennion begins the processe of removing large asphalt materials that were buried around the line and below the line. We believe when the active line was being installed the old road pieces were just tossed in the hole and buried surrounding the active line, rather then being properly disposed of. We believe this also played a major role of the damaged line. The pictures below is large pieces of asphalt that are sitting near and below the line on both sides. Installing any utility in this intersection would cause this line to have a extremely high risk of damage.



Approximately 12:45-1:30

Landmarks excavator shows up on site

Taylorsville Bennion begins removing Concrete poured all around waterline. This concrete was poured to act as a thrust block when the line was installed. This is not the proper way to install a thrust block. This concrete pouring surrounded the entire base of the line. Concrete surrounding this large section of pipe make the pipe brittle and subject to break when pressure is near by. This along with the asphalt pieces in the ground is what ended up causing the line to break as our bore head was passing beneath the line. The installation of this line was installed improperly in every way and does not meet the proper specs. Below are photos of the poured thrust block and submitted plans to install thrust blocks in Utah city's. We also have video of Taylorsville Bennion removing the surrounding concrete.
