SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION

CenturyLink Communications, LLC (FRN: 0018-4219-41), (referred to herein as "CenturyLink") hereby applies for authority to grandfather certain Voice over Internet Protocol ("VoIP") services provided in all 50 states, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico that have operated on a VoIP platform with aging support capabilities.

CenturyLink submits the following information in support of its application:

1. Name and address of carrier

2. Date of planned service discontinuance

CenturyLink plans to grandfather the Affected Services on September 29, 2023, or as soon thereafter as any necessary regulatory approvals are obtained.

3. Points of geographic areas of service affected

CenturyLink seeks authority to grandfather the VoIP services all 50 states, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico.

4. Brief description of the type of services affected

CenturyLink is seeking to grandfather the following VoIP services:

- Sonus SIP Trunk provides voice-grade telephonic communications services providing channels (sessions/concurrent call paths) that carry a variety of applications including long distance, toll-free and ability to place and receive phone calls.
- SIP Trunk IAD Bundle/Core Connect Enterprise SIP IAD Bundle & Fiber+ Enterprise SIP IAD Package provides up to 46 Sonus SIP channels, telephone numbers, local access, a public or private network connection, rental Integrated Access Device hardware (IAD), all designed to integrate with a Digital PBX.
- Hosted Integrated Voice Response (Hosted IVR or HIVR) allows a caller to self-serve using Dual Tone Multiple Frequency or Speech recognition, and then be routed to the correct destination.
- Interaction Routing is the suite of contact center products that routes customer calls to the correct agents and attaches data that allows the caller's information to follow the call.

5. Brief description of the dates and methods of notice to all affected customers

CenturyLink sent a written notification of the planned grandfathering to customers affected by the proposed grandfathering in accordance with Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's Rules. Customer notifications were sent by U.S. Mail or United Parcel Service on April.24, 2023 and May 2, 2023. Copies of the notifications are attached to this application (Attachment A).

6. Dominance of carrier with respect to the service to be discontinued

CenturyLink is a non-dominant carrier with regard to affected VoIP services.

7. Service

In accordance with 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a), CenturyLink has mailed a copy of this application to the Governor and public utility commission of each of the affected states and jurisdictions identified in Paragraph 3 above, to any federally-recognized Tribal Nations with authority over the Tribal lands in the geographic areas identified in Paragraph 3 above, as well as to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications under the Secretary of Defense.

- Moves, Adds and Changes for Sonus SIP Trunk and SIP Trunk IAD Bundle/Core Connect Enterprise SIP IAD Bundle will be limited to 911 location updates, where available; Caller ID Name to maintain compliance; and the porting of numbers to other services. If the underlying transport is impacted by a TDM discontinuation, a change order is permitted. Customers of these services can maintain current product configurations for the duration of current service terms, but to make any other changes going forward, they will need to migrate their services to one of CenturyLink's newer VoIP services.
- Moves, Adds and Changes for **Hosted Interaction Routing** are not impacted.
