SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION

CenturyLink Communications, LLC (FRN: 0018-4219-41),¹ (referred to herein as

"CenturyLink") hereby applies for authority to discontinue three Voice over Internet Protocol

("VoIP") services in thirty-four states that have operated on a VoIP platform with aging support

capabilities.

CenturyLink submits the following information in support of its application:

1. Name and address of carrier

2. Date of planned service discontinuance

CenturyLink plans to discontinue the Affected Services on October 13, 2023, or as soon

thereafter as any necessary regulatory approvals are obtained.

3. Points of geographic areas of service affected

CenturyLink seeks authority to discontinue the Affected Services in the states of

Alabama, Arkansas, Arizona, Colorado, Florida, Iowa, Idaho, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky,

Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Mississippi, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Jersey, New

Mexico, New York, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, South

Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia, Washington, Wisconsin and

Wyoming.

4. Brief description of the type of services affected

CenturyLink is seeking to discontinue the following VoIP services:

Digital Home Phone (or DHP) service is a residential voice service delivered over an IP infrastructure (VoIP) and includes features customers normally associate with landline service such as the ability to make and receive voice calls (local and long distance), Caller ID, emergency 9-1-1 calling, voicemail, 3-way calling, and call blocking.

Business VoIP (or BVoIP) is a Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) based service which provides PSTN access for TDM and IP telephony customer premises equipment for Small Business customers.

Simple VoIP service is a service delivered over an IP infrastructure (VoIP) and includes features customers normally associate with landline service such as the ability to make and receive voice calls (local and long distance), Caller ID, emergency 9-1-1 calling, voicemail, 3-way calling, and call blocking.

5. Brief description of the dates and methods of notice to all affected customers

CenturyLink sent a written notification of the planned discontinuance to customers

affected by the proposed discontinuance in accordance with Section 63.71(a) of the

Commission's Rules. Customer notifications were sent by U.S. Mail or United Parcel Service on

August 10, 2023. A copy of the notification is attached to this application (Attachment A).

6. Dominance of carrier with respect to the service to be discontinued

CenturyLink Communications, LLC is a non-dominant carrier with regard to the Affected Services.

7. Service

In accordance with 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a), CenturyLink Communications, LLC has mailed a copy of this application to the Governor and public utility commission of each of the affected states and jurisdictions identified in Paragraph 3 above, to any federally-recognized Tribal Nations with authority over the Tribal lands in the geographic areas identified in Paragraph 3 above, as well as to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications under the Secretary of Defense.

Important Notice Regarding the Planned Discontinuance of Digital Home Phone, Simple VoIP and Business VoIP Service Provided by CenturyLink Communications, LLC, a Lumen Company

We continually evaluate the products and services we offer to customers, and occasionally our evaluation results in changes.

As of **October 13, 2023**, or as soon after that date as authorized by the Federal Communications Commission and the state regulatory commission, if required, CenturyLink Communications, LLC will discontinue the following three phone services:

- 1) Digital Home Phone
- 2) Simple Voice over Internet Protocol (Simple VoIP)
- 3) Business Voice over Internet Protocol (Business VoIP or BVoIP)

These services are provided in the following states via systems that are being decommissioned: Alabama, Arkansas, Arizona, Colorado, Florida, Iowa, Idaho, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Mississippi, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia, Washington, Wisconsin and Wyoming

Existing contracts for this service will NOT be renewed, and there will be no early termination penalties for the affected service.

YOUR NEXT STEPS TO BE COMPLETED ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1, 2023:

- If you want to keep your existing phone number, you will need to check with other providers <u>prior</u> to September 1, 2023, to find out if your number is available on their network. Unfortunately, we're unable to transfer your current number to our new CenturyLink VoIP service. We recommend contacting other providers right away to avoid interruption of your voice service. You do not need to contact us if you move your phone service to another provider.
- If you're interested in subscribing to a different CenturyLink VoIP service and being assigned a new telephone number, contact us at 877-299-0211 no later than September 1, 2023, to determine eligibility. Please advise the agent of your existing DHP, Simple VoIP or BVoIP account. Note—we will not be able to use your existing phone number.
- If you do not want to continue phone service and do not want to make any changes to your CenturyLink internet service, you do not need to do anything further. Your phone service will be disconnected October 13, 2023, or soon after.

Your other services from CenturyLink

• If you subscribe to other services from CenturyLink, those services will NOT be impacted by the discontinuance of the services listed above.

Your bill after Digital Home Phone, Simple VolP or BVolP service is discontinued.

- When your Digital Home Phone, Simple VoIP or BVoIP service is discontinued, we will automatically apply any deposits or credits, if applicable, to your CenturyLink Communications, LLC bill.
- If the amount of the bill is less than any deposits and credits, we will issue a refund for the remaining balance.
