Dear Mr. Weians,

On December 18, 2025, the Public Service Commission (PSC) received your correspondence on behalf of Sprint Spectrum LLC ("Sprint") stating that as of 2023, Sprint ceased providing wireless operations. Sprint further states that during 2023, Sprint's customers were transferred to T-Mobile West LLC ("T-Mobile") and T-Mobile continues to file Utah Universal Service Fund reports which include former Sprint subscriber connections. Sprint requests it be removed from any future filing obligations or remittances. On January 13, 2026, the PSC issued an action request to the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) asking it to review Sprint's correspondence and verify whether Sprint has a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) or eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) designation and to provide a recommendation addressing the question Sprint posed in its correspondence.

On February 11, 2026, DPU filed its action request response. DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge Sprint does not have a CPCN and Sprint's ETC designation was relinquished by the PSC on March 10, 2011. You were courtesy copied on DPU's response. The PSC acknowledges that Sprint does not have a CPCN and its ETC designation was relinquished on March 10, 2011, and based on Sprint's representations in its December 18, 2025, letter concerning its Utah operations, Sprint's correspondence has been filed and posted to Docket No. 25-999-03.
